Terry Brennan, Senior Standards Engineer, Equipment Division, Office of Energy Efficiency Natural Resources Canada.

Terry gave a very interesting presentation on the proposed Premium Efficiency Motor regulation that will affect most motors between 1HP and 500HP.
 The presentation outlined the process and time line that the government uses to pass this type of legislation.
 It will improve motor efficiency on average between .4 to 3%. It will where ever possible harmonize with the proposed US legislation.
 The scope of motors will be increased to include U Frame, Design C, IEC, Vertical, Close Coupled Pump, Footless, 8 pole as well as others.
