PRESENTED BY: Gene Vogel, Pump & Vibration Specialist, EASA. Before joining EASA as Pump and Vibration Specialist, Gene Vogel operated his own business, General Maintenance Equipment/Engineering, Inc. (GME), a marketing, service and training organization for industrial maintenance and related technologies. Among other courses, he taught a "Pumps and Pump Systems" seminar for American Trainco. He also has an extensive background in vibration and dynamic balancing, and chaired the St. Louis Chapter of the Vibration Institute from 1993-2000.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM: The seminar will cover the common repair procedures for centrifugal pumps, including submersible pumps, vertical turbine pumps, single stage end suction pumps and split case pumps. The procedures are also applicable to other style pumps. For each type of pump, the inspection, disassembly, evaluation, repair and reassembly functions are presented. EASA ONTARIO CHAPTER DEPENDS ON YOUR SUPPORT

When EASA Ontario Chapter negotiates hotel contracts, meeting rooms and hospitality suites are generally provided free of charge. These “free” meeting rooms are the result of a guarantee by the Ontario Chapter that a certain number of guest rooms will be booked. If the target number of rooms is not filled, the chapter is responsible for the cost of these unused rooms. Since contracts may be negotiated a year or more in advance of the meeting, there is no way of knowing what the hotel demand will be at the time of the meeting. The Ontario Chapter does its very best to ensure that guest rooms are priced as low as possible. Occasionally better rates than EASA quotes can be found on the internet or by booking directly with the hotel close to the event date. By booking through EASA, you are contributing to the success of the chapter by helping meet the guest room quota. This in turn reduces the operating costs of the meetings and allows the chapter to give back to the organization through high quality meetings, activities, low-cost courses and free transportation to and from events.
